Ethnic Categories	Number of Participating Children or Adults
Hispanic or Latino. (A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race).	
Not Hispanic or Latino. (All persons not fitting in one of the above describes categories)	
Race Categories	Number of Participating Children or Adults
American Indian or Alaska Native. (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America, (including Central America), and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition (includes Aleuts and Eskimos).	
Asian. (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent, including, for example, Cambodia, China, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam).	
Black or African American. (A person having origins in black racial groups of Africa).	
Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands).	
White. (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East).

ETHNIC AND RACIAL DATA FORM

Instructions for Completing the Ethnic and Racial Data Form

- **The sponsor should complete this form for each site every year.**
- **The sponsor may use visual identification to determine a participant's ethnic and/or racial category. A participant may be included in the group that he/she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded as a member by the community.**
- **Each participant should be counted under only one category for ethnicity and only one category for race. The total number of children or adults marked under both the ethnic and racial categories should equal the total number of participating children or adults in attendance on the day the form is completed.**
- **The sponsor must retain ethnic and racial data for 3 years and must safeguard this information. Access to Program records containing racial/ethnic data should be limited to authorized personnel.**
