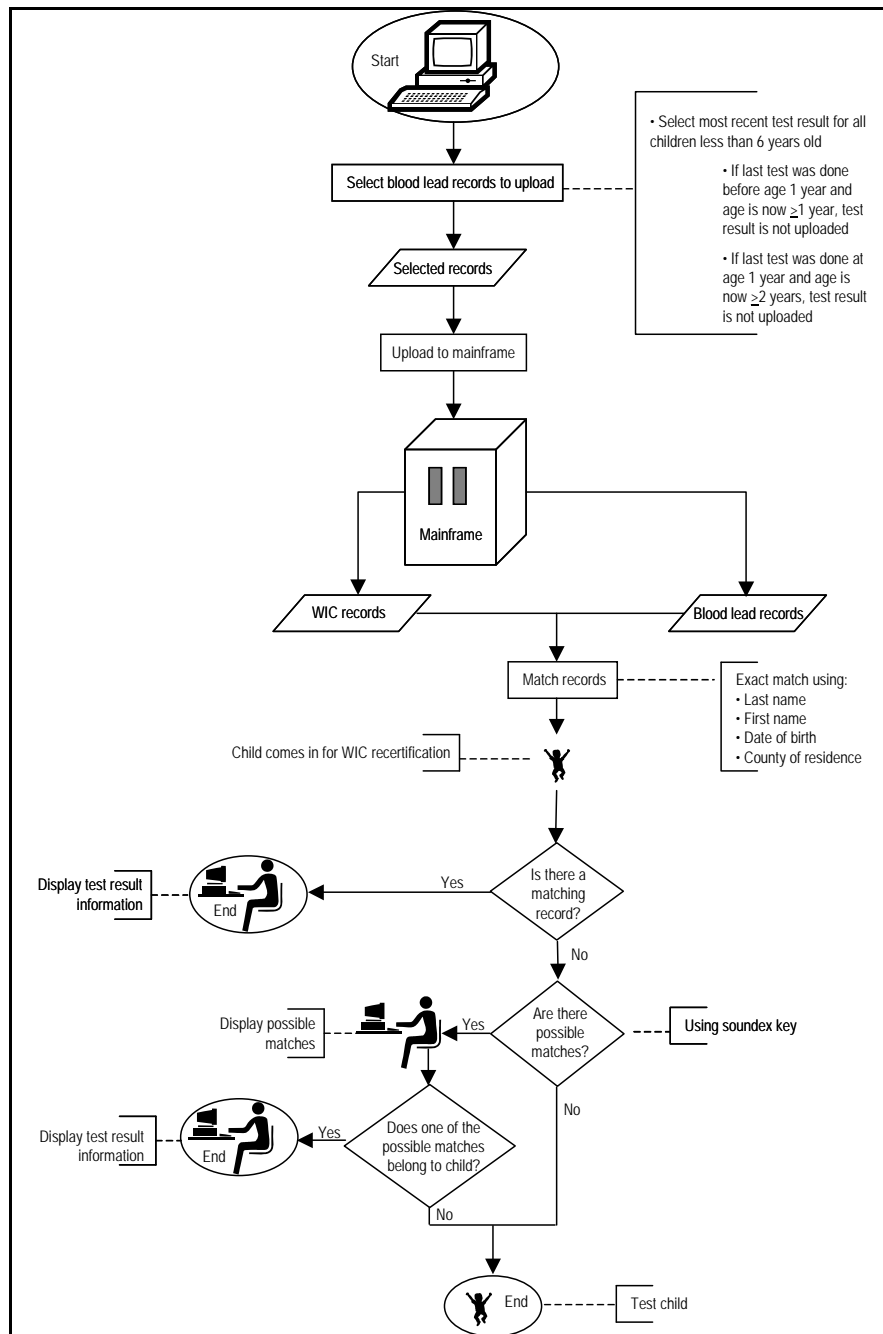


Blood Lead Level Inquiry (Screen 54)

Blood lead level values are transferred to the WIC certification screen 20 from the Lead Poisoning Prevention Program Laboratory System (LPPPLS) on the first Tuesday of each month. Data transfers are completed for children who have been tested for lead **and** who participate in the WIC program **and** whose records match when the results are transferred.

The following flow chart depicts how lead results are made available to HSIS users.



Screen 20

If data appears in the Lead Field of the WIC Certification (Screen 20), located just before medical nutritional risk codes, it indicates that there was a perfect match between the WIC patient master participant name and LPPPLS for that child. When there is a match, the blood lead value will be displayed as well as the month and year of the test.

If no data appears in the Lead Field of the WIC Certification (Screen 20), the user should do an inquiry on screen 54 (Blood Lead Level Inquiry). WIC and other authorized HSIS Users have only View access to this data.

Screen 54

Screen 54 lists lead levels for individuals with a similar name but who do not bring up a perfect match for name, date of birth, sex, address, and other variables. Screen 54 can help WIC and other local agency staff determine if a child has been screened for lead and provide the date on which the screening was completed. If a child or children with similar names in the same county have been screened for lead, the following will be listed:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- County Number
- Child's City of Residence
- Lead Results
- Lead Test Date
- Medicaid ID number
- Child's address
