SUBJECT: Free and Reduced Price Eligibility Data

The State Agency is required to make available school data to Institutions participating in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and Sponsors participating in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP.) The State agency will make this data available on the Nutrition Services Branch website. The website address is nutritionnc.com. Please print this data from the website if you need it to determine eligibility for participation in the CACFP or the SFSP. If you do not have access to the website and need a hard copy of the data, please contact Adrienne Powell at (919) 707-5767.

If you are sponsoring an after school “at risk” program, this data should be used to determine if the center is located in an area which the school is at least 50% needy. Also, this school data is used to determine Tier I eligibility for day care home providers participating in the CACFP. Lastly, this data is used to determine “area eligibility” for open sites and closed enrolled sites in the Summer Food Service Program.
